Modern Dwelling One & Two-Point Perspective Assignment 2D Design / Lehigh University AAD / Murphy



One and Two-Point perspective will be used to create imaginary modern dwellings. This project is inspired by Frank Lloyd Wright's, Fallingwater house.

The drawing must include:

- One and/or Two-Point perspective
- Be a livable space and a cohesive unit
- Have 5 or more boxes on different levels
- Have surrounding embellishments (landscape / environment)
- Make good use of the page (no small drawings floating on the page)
- Variety of siding / textures

Step 1:

Divide sketchbook page into 4 equal sections Make 3-4 thumbnail sketches of stacked boxes Research modern architects and note the name of architect or firm on sketches

Step 2:

Choose the best sketch and draw full scale in pencil. Make sure to fulfill all 6 requirements. Use extended vanishing points

Tools: 11" x 14" Drawing Pad Pencil HB, 2B, 4B Ruler & Eraser
